Dear Ms. Federman:

I am writing in response to the Application for Approval and Provider Agreement that was submitted to this office. A review of this document and supporting materials has now been completed. I am pleased to inform you that Magenu has been approved as a provider of the coursework required by Chapter 544 of the New York State Laws of 1988 regarding the identification and reporting and reporting of child abuse and maltreatment. As you know, Chapter 544 requires that training in the identification and reporting of child abuse and maltreatment be taken by chiropractors, dental hygienists, dentists, optometrists, physicians, podiatrists, psychologists, registered nurses, licensed clinical social workers, licensed master social workers, mental health counselors, marriage and family therapists, creative arts therapists, psychoanalyst, school administrators/supervisors, school service personnel, and school teachers.

Pursuant to Section 57.3(a) of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education, this approval is valid through **9/30/2015**. At the expiration of this period, your organization may reapply to the State Education Department for approval as a provider. Termination of a provider's approved status may result from a determination by the Department, pursuant to Section 57.5(b) of the Commissioner's Regulations, that the coursework offered by that provider is inadequate, incomplete, or otherwise unsatisfactory. The Department may therefore review and evaluate the coursework offered by approved providers.


This notification constitutes approval to offer the mandated coursework in child abuse identification and reporting in live lecture format under the terms and conditions of the application and provider agreement filed with this office. Before any major modifications may be made which affect those terms and conditions, including mode of delivery, separate approval must be obtained from the New York State Education Department.

By copy of this letter, we notify the New York State Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) that you are an approved provider for this training. OCFS will provide a copy of the updated curriculum to be used for this training.

A copy of the Certification of Completion form to be issued to persons successfully completing the training are enclosed. You will need to duplicate this form and provide the trainee with the original and one copy. It is the trainee's responsibility to submit the original copy of this certification form to the State Education Department at the appropriate time. Providers must maintain a hard copy or electronic record of the certificate form for not less than five years from the date the course was completed. Your Certification of Completion forms should be kept in a secure location. Please note that the Provider Identification Number assigned above must be included on all authorized Certification of Completion forms. Should you ever wish to write or call concerning this approval, please make reference to the above Provider Identification Number. This will assist our office in responding to your inquiry.
